**At the moment this is the advises:**

“The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is maintaining its global advice against all non-essential travel to all countries. This advice currently applies until 20 August. However, from 15 June, the advice no longer applies to other Nordic countries where the infection situation meets the criteria set by the Norwegian Institute of Public Health.”

**If you have plans for travels abroad in the coming summer and fall for work/field work or meeting outside Nordic countries, all tickets and hotel etc booked must be with full possibility for cancellation without cost.**

Your travel insurance through Eurocard or other private insurance will most probably not cover cost related for travel booked to countries we are not recommended to visit.
